Background

The Standalone Face-Seal (SFS) (1) is an accessory for all AYO[™] WX half-face masks (HFM) including the Standard (HFM) (2), Welding (HFM-W), and Speech-Enhanced (HFM-SP).

This Guide will illustrate the steps to attach the **SFS** accessory to the **HFM** to create the **HFM/SFS** mask assembly.






 Lay the mask down on the work surface as shown and place the headstrap (1) and harness (2) out of the way.



2. Wrap the **SFS** around the bottom of the mask with the *Velcro patches* (1) facing outward. These patches can be used to align the **SFS** by ensuring the *exhalation valve* (2) is in-between.



3. Take the side *elastic ribbons* (1) and wrap them over the front of the mask to reach the *Velcro patches* (2) from Step 2. Make sure the *ribbons* don't cross over the mask *headstraps* (3). The end result should be like the right-hand image (4).





- 4. Do final checks on face-seal and straps.
- 4.1 The **SFS** should wrap snugly (1) around the **HFM** leaving no gaps.
- 4.2 Neither component should have straps crossing over each other; the SFS should be bounded by the HFM headstrap (2) and harness (3).
- 4.3 The elastic backstrap (4) of the **SFS** should be freely out in the open.





- 5.1 Begin donning the mask assembly by looping the **HFM** headstrap (1) behind the neck.
- 5.2 Second, take the SFS backstrap (2) and place it behind the head, adjust until comfortable.
- 5.3 Finally, position the **HFM** harness (3) on top of the head and adjust all components as necessary.
- 5.4 Pull to adjust the **SFS** *tabs* (4) for best coverage and fit.
